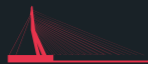

How to get there

From Rotterdam Airport Turn left onto the N209. After 750 yards turn right and continue southwards to the A13/E19. Take the exit signposted Rotterdam Centrum and follow signs to Centrum. On the Hofplein roundabout go straight on and take the first right (Kruiskade) to the Hilton Rotterdam hotel.
Distance 10 km; drive time 15 min; taxi ± 30 Euro; Airport shuttle 33 and 50

From Amsterdam Airport Schiphol Take A4 Hwy South toward The Hague. At junction Ypenburg continue on the A13 Southeast to Rotterdam. Take the exit signposted Rotterdam Centrum and follow signs to Centrum. On the Hofplein roundabout go straight on and take the first right (Kruiskade) to the Hilton Rotterdam hotel.
Distance 60 km; drive time 60-120 min; Train from Schiphol Airport to Rotterdam Central Station every 15 minutes (± 45 minutes)

By Train Hilton Rotterdam is located at walking distance (500 meter) of Rotterdam Central Station.

By Car Follow signs to Rotterdam Centrum. On the Hofplein roundabout go straight on and take the first right (Kruiskade) to the Hilton Rotterdam hotel.

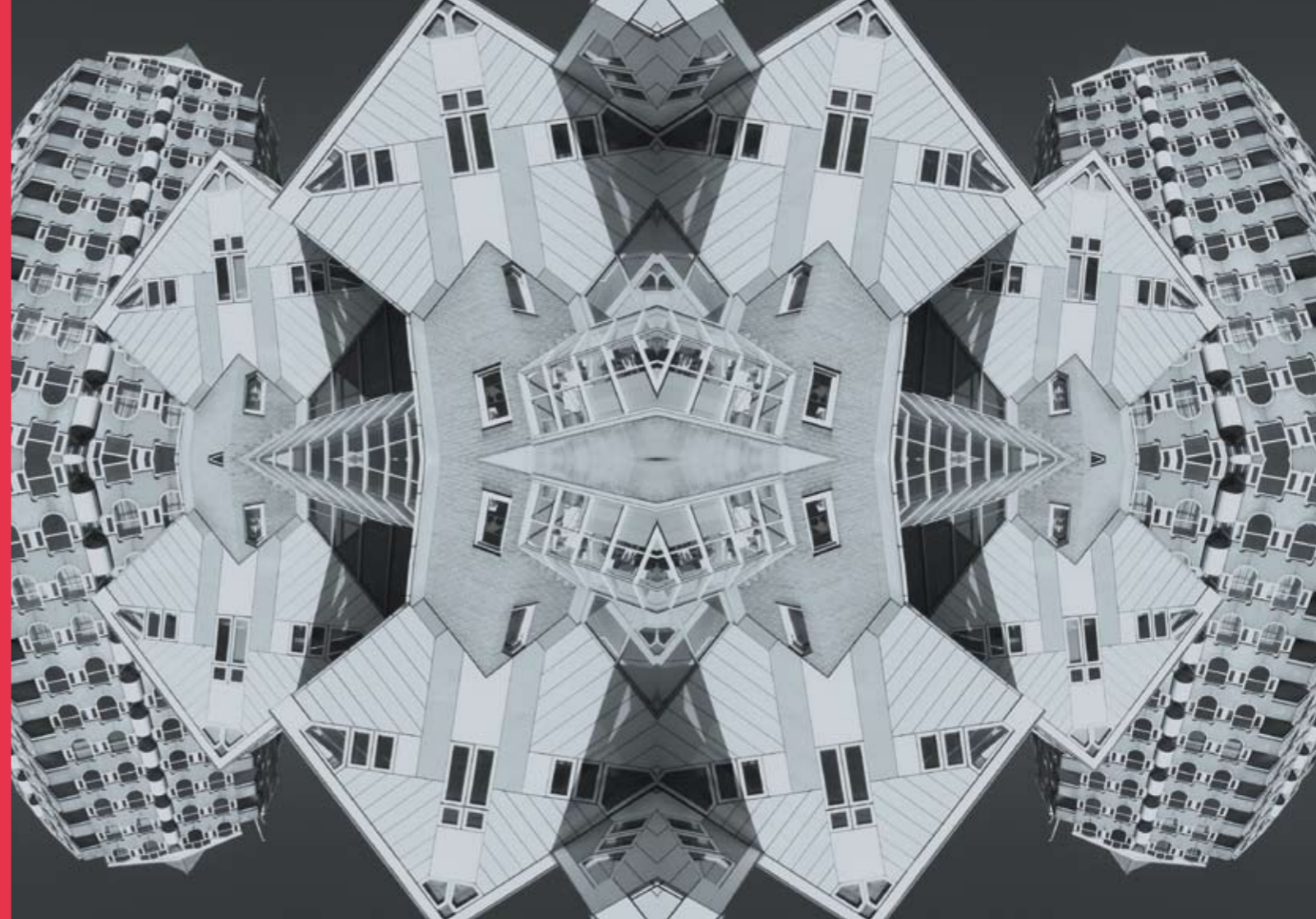
